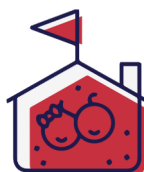

The *Passerelle* integration program: A tailored support for non-French-speaking students

The Passerelle Programme is specifically designed to welcome and **support non-French-speaking students** whose mother tongue is not French. Its aim is to facilitate their gradual integration into the French education system while enabling them to rapidly develop their language and academic skills.

Through intensive and adapted teaching of French as the language of schooling (FLSco), students acquire the foundations they need to confidently follow classroom learning. The programme focuses on oral comprehension, written and spoken expression, as well as academic vocabulary, helping students develop independence and confidence throughout their educational journey.

Support is provided in **small groups, with differentiated activities and a variety of educational resources**, allowing us to respond to the specific needs of each student.

The Passerelle Programme is progressive: as students develop their French language skills, they are **gradually integrated** into mainstream classes until they are able to participate fully.

Open Doors to the AEFÉ Network:

All our classes, from the first year of preschool (Petite Section) to the final year of high school (Terminale), are accredited by the French Ministry of Education through the network of the Agency for French Education Abroad (AEFE). This accreditation guarantees that our school meets the requirements of the French education system and ensures the quality and consistency of the education provided.

As part of a worldwide network of more than 500 schools in nearly 140 countries, the Collège International Français de Sarajevo offers its students unique educational continuity: regardless of the country, the curricula, teaching methods and qualifications are the same. This network enables students to continue their education at another French school abroad or in France without any disruption to their academic journey.

At the end of 9th grade (Troisième), students have several options. They can continue their education at the French high school and prepare for the French Baccalauréat, a qualification recognised in more than 170 countries and providing access to French universities, the Grandes Écoles and numerous leading international programmes. Some students also choose to attend local Bosnian high schools.

The educational pathways students begin in high school naturally continue into higher education, both in France and internationally. Each year, our students enter demanding and highly regarded fields of study, including law, political science, medicine, business and engineering. These achievements reflect the academic excellence and comprehensive education provided by our school.

Strong English proficiency: A distinctive advantage for our students

Building on their primary school education, our middle school students receive extensive English instruction, enabling them to reach B2 level (upper-intermediate/advanced).

Learning German and Spanish

In middle school, students have the opportunity to learn a second foreign language: German or Spanish.

Learning an additional language promotes international openness, cultural curiosity, and provides a valuable asset for continuing their studies in high school and beyond.

Preparation for language certifications

Language proficiency is a key pillar of student success. From Grade 9 (Troisième), students are prepared for the DELF B2 with a qualified teacher, enabling them to obtain an internationally recognized French-language certification. This certification is a valuable asset for pursuing further studies in a French-speaking environment.

In addition, the high school is currently developing preparation programmes for Cambridge English Qualifications, giving students the opportunity to certify their English proficiency according to international standards. These certifications strengthen students' academic profiles and facilitate international mobility.

Activities Throughout the Year



Extracurricular activities

From Grande Section (the final year of preschool), students have the opportunity to take part in a wide range of extracurricular activities offered after school.

Our school offers a varied programme of sports, cultural and artistic activities, allowing every child to discover their talents, develop their creativity and thrive.



Homework support

Homework support provides students with guidance and assistance as they complete their independent work.

Supervised by their class teacher, students can review concepts covered in class, ensure they fully understand the instructions and organise their work in a calm and structured environment.

This programme aims to develop students' independence, effective and consistent study habits, and self-confidence.



Before - and After-School Care

We offer daily before- and after-school care, from 7:30 to 8:30 a.m. and in the afternoon until 5:30 p.m. Students are welcomed in a safe and caring environment under the supervision of qualified school staff. This service provides families with greater flexibility while ensuring that children receive attentive care before and after classes.



Holiday camps

During school holidays, the school offers holiday camps open to students from preschool onwards. Our camps encourage students' learning and development in a fun, caring and stimulating environment. The programme includes educational and recreational activities, sports and arts activities, creative workshops, group games, outings, age-appropriate themed projects, as well as French language classes to strengthen students' language skills.

Facilities and services designed to support our students' well-being and development

• School Catering

Our school catering service offers menus tailored to children's nutritional needs, using a varied selection of quality ingredients to meet students' expectations. We aim to provide balanced meals, prioritising fresh, natural foods over frozen or highly processed products, while also educating students about the importance of a complete and balanced diet.

• The Library

The library is a space dedicated to curiosity and learning. Students can borrow a wide range of books and resources.

This welcoming environment encourages independence, concentration and a love of reading. Regular book- and reading-related activities are organised to stimulate students' interest in literature and broaden their cultural knowledge.

• Sports Facilities

This space enables our students to practise a variety of sports as part of their classes, extracurricular activities and holiday camps.

• School Transportation

School transportation is organised by the school to make everyday life easier for families. Minibuses pick up students from their homes each morning and take them to school, then bring them home after classes. This service provides a convenient, reliable and safe solution for students' daily journeys.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS



1. APPLICATION FILE

Complete your application online via the Edeka portal.
Documents to upload: school reports and copies of the parents' and child's passports.



2. APPLICATION REVIEW & EDUCATIONAL INTERVIEW

After submitting your application, you will be offered an educational interview within 5 working days.



3. ADMISSION DECISION

Following the admissions committee's decision, your child's place will be confirmed by email within 2–3 days.
